

Among employed adults who say that, for the most part, the responsibilities of their job can be done from home, % saying they \_\_\_\_ all or most of the time







## **Slack Basics**




- Accessible through Slack desktop app, mobile app, or browser
- Invitation sent to e-mail
- Creating an account and joining a workspace is free

#### <u>Terminology</u>

- Workspace: Single place for your team and work.
- Channel: Conversations on or for a particular department, project, topic, team, etc. within the overarching workspace. All members of a channel can see posts, files, etc.
- Direct messages: One-to-one conversation between you and another member
- Mentions: Use the @ sign followed by a member's name to mention them specifically. The member will receive a notification.

How Workplaces Use Communication Platforms



- Limit or expand conversation to relevant people
- Share files
- Collaborate in real time
- Create social "water cooler" spaces
- Personalize messages with emojis and GIFs
- Integrate apps



Choosing a New Communication Platform

- Does your institution already use a platform?
  - Speak to your IT Department beforehand
- Ask yourself:
  - Who will use this?
  - How will we use it?
  - What functions do we absolutely need?
- Consider
  - Security concerns
  - Free/paid subscription packages
  - Possible limits on number of users, file sizes, etc.
  - Learning curve for staff





## Final Thoughts

- Technology is changing how we are working, both individually and, especially, as teams
- Communication platforms, like Slack, will likely be used long after workplaces return to business as usual
- Whatever work you and your coworkers do, there is almost certainly an app that can help and multiple online guides and reviews to help you select the best option
