**Presentation.** ([Rebecca Reynolds](#), Chair & Associate Professor of Library & Information Science, Rutgers School of Communication & Information)

- *Governing EdTech in Schools & Universities through Multifactor EdTech Data Ethics Advocacy (MEDEA).*
- RR discussed her 3 Strands of research:
  - Digital information literacy development among young people: past, present, future
  - Socio-technical systems research and critical education technology platform studies (aka "education informatics")
  - Traditional reading skills development, reasoning, and new literacy development in the socio-technical era
- [Sins of omission: Critical informatics perspectives on privacy in e-learning systems in higher education](#)
- Discussion about the personal data harvesting happening with products like Turnitin and privacy concerns – what is happening with all of the data? What is the value of the learning objects instructors create on these platforms? Should we be thinking about hiring contracts? Is the data being commercialized?
- Gus – challenge to get rid of (Turnitin) – instructors are used to using it, they don't want to get rid of it. Harvesting personal data is happening. It is very concerning.

- RR is interested in VALE's connection to NJ Edge w/ Research – AH will follow up and introduce it to Forough @ Edge.

  - Thank you to our members – for renewing resources, sharing work, attending the conference – we will continue to add resources and events.   - Proposed 0.278 increase in service fee – 3.9007%
  - Elizabeth Leonard asked about the 10k rollover – will we need to do this every year to keep the service fee low? No.
  - MNO moved to approve the proposed FY25 budget. Motion to pass proposed FY25 budget passed: 27 Yes; 0 No; 0 Abstain.
