LitBase is a global literature database with critical primary and secondary sources to support research of the most studied authors, poetry, fiction, plays and creative nonfiction.

Content:

- Offers full text of writing collections from diverse parts of the world
- Celebrates authors from traditionally marginalized groups such as LGBTQ+, American minority populations, Indigenous people, Black authors and women authors
- Includes the classics of the Western canon
- Provides 1.5+ million full-text primary and secondary source records
- Includes literary criticism, poetry criticism, book reviews and author interviews

Features:

- Integrates with the MLA International Bibliography
- Includes a unique literature thesaurus with 6,400 terms
- Provides a literary period limiter and advanced search
- Allows browsing by topic and genre
- Delivers author pages with author biographies and related search results
