

- Info Sessions and Mentoring Meetings






The Breakdown:

 - **Codex** – “NJIT Library Navigator”




The Breakdown:

How It Went:

- A lot of work up-front and at the end
 - Lining up judges, speakers, rooms, supplies



 - Look outside the library



Lessons Learned
